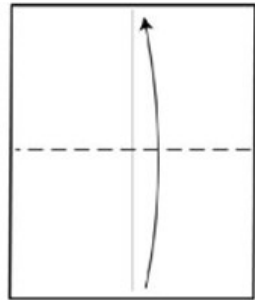
Materials

- Coloured construction paper or newspaper (12x18 inches or 12X9 inches)
- Markers, pencil crayons, or crayons
- Glue Stick
- Printed photos of Onkel Hans (page 3)
- Folding Instructions (page 2)
- Craft feathers (optional)

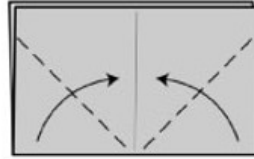
Instructions

1. Have all your materials laid out in front of you, including the folding instruction sheet.
2. Have an adult put on THEMUSEUM's Kidtoberfest Hat video.
3. Follow the video or the paper hat instruction sheet below.
4. Once you've folded your hat, you can start decorating it!
 - a. Feel free to add photos of Onkel Hans or a daisy which can be printed from page 3
 - b. Decorate your hat using any craft materials you have at home.
5. That's it! Now wear your hat and celebrate Oktoberfest.

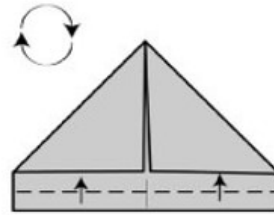
Folding Instructions



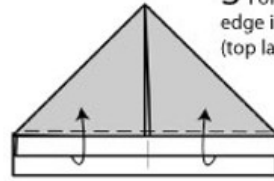
1 Fold a sheet of newspaper in half



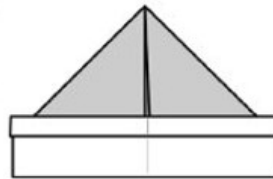
2 Fold each half of the lower edge to the vertical centre



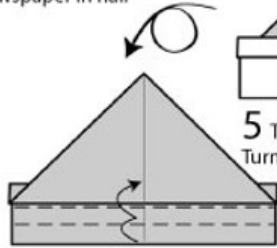
3 Fold the lower edge in half (top layer only)



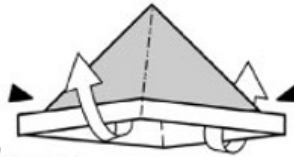
4 Swing the thin double layer flap upwards



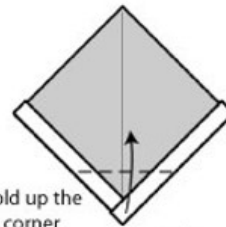
5 This is the result. Turn the paper over



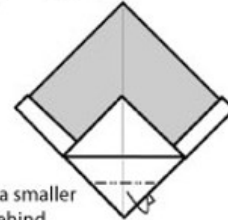
6 Repeat steps 3 and 4 on this side



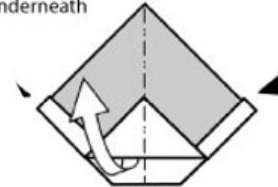
7 Put your hands inside and press open, squashing in half the other way



8 Fold up the lower corner



9 Fold a smaller corner behind underneath



10 Open into a hat shape
