# Turkey Table Decoration

## Materials

- o Autumn coloured craft paper (we chose dark brown, orange & yellow)
- o Red craft paper (red, brown & white)
- o 2x Googly Eyes
- o Feathers
- o Scissors
- o Clear
- o Tape
- o Glue Gun (ask and adult for help!) or White Glue
- o Stickers/Bingo Dabbers/Markers/ Crayons (optional for decoration)



## Instructions

Step 1:

Prepare your turkey pieces! See below for each piece in the corresponding photo

1. Dark Brown paper: Cut two (2) 11.0" x 4.5" rectangles
2. Orange paper: Cut two (2) 10.0" x 3.5" rectangles
3. Yellow paper: Cut two (2) 9.0" x 3.0" rectangles
4. White Paper: Cut one (1) 4.0" x 2.0" rectangle
5. Cut a drumstick-shape out of the brown paper
6. Cut a 2.5" circle out of the brown paper
7. Using the red paper, cut a small heart-shape for the turkey's wattle
8. Take the orange paper and cut a small triangle for the beak

## Step 2: Assemble your turkey!

o Take the drumstick and put the skinny part pointing down. Glue the eyes, wattle and beak on. Glue some feather to the back of the head

o Glue the brown circle to the tip of the neck. Fold where the dotted line in the image is so the turkey stands up. Put the turkey body aside



o Take the six (6) coloured paper rectangles and fold each one back-and-forth like an accordion or fan

o Take each pair of rectangles and tape them together so you have one long accordion/fan folded strip

o Next, bring the ends together to form a fan and tape/glue them together. Do this for all 3 strips and put them aside.

o Grab the turkey's body and the white strip. Glue the strip to the folded part of the turkey's body, so it has a "base"

o Finally, take each of your folded fans, glue them to the white strip in order of shortest (near the turkey's body) to tallest

## Step 3: Decorate!

o Add some decorations to your turkey! Use extra feathers, pencil crayons, markers, bingo dabbers, stickers, or whatever you can find to add some flair to your turkey. It's your chance to get creative and make it unique!
