

DATES: October 11-13, 2024

***EARLY BIRD:** SAVE \$50 off vendor fee if application is submitted by April 1, 2024

APPLICATION DEADLINE: July 1, 2024

VENDOR MARKET HOURS: Event runs rain or shine

Friday, October 11th 10am-7pm Saturday, October 12th 10am-7pm Sunday, October 13th 10am-7pm **LOCATION:** King Street + Carl Zehr Square + Kitchener City Hall, Downtown Kitchener

VENDOR FEES:

Food Truck - \$1000 + HST King Street Vendor (8' Hut) - \$300 + HST Indoor City Hall Vendor (10'x10' space) - \$300 + HST Carl Zehr Square Vendor* (8' Hut) - \$500 + HST (*CZS Vendor hours are 10am-10pm daily)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Step 1: Complete the vendor application online at oktoberfest.ca/willkommenplatz.

Step 2: If accepted, you will receive an emailed admission of application and invoice.

Step 3: To secure your spot, payment must be received and can be made via credit card or EFT.

Please include the following with your application:

- Copy of liability insurance and/or insurance certificate in the amount of two million dollars (five million dollars for food vendors). Upon acceptance, K-W Oktoberfest Inc. must be added as additional insured.
- Current health inspection must accompany each application for food vendors only.
- City of Kitchener Vendor's Permit Number, if applicable.
- Photo of your booth or products.

Willkommen to the 56th annual Kitchener-Waterloo Oktoberfest! The hub of K-W Oktoberfest is located at the Willkommen Platz in Downtown Kitchener, along King Street from Ontario Street to Kitchener City Hall. Raise a stein in our biergarten, savour authentic Bavarian cuisine from one of our food vendors, shop our local vendor market, or sing along in front of the stage at one of our live performances. Be part of this year's Festival and apply for vendor space today! Apply online at oktoberfest.ca/willkommenplatz.

Vendor Responsibilities

- Ability to adapt to the Bavarian theme of the Festival.
- Load in and set up will take place on the afternoon of Thursday, October 10th. All vendors must be present and ready for inspection by Fire and Public Health at 10am on Friday, October 11th. Vendors not registered with the City of Kitchener will need to schedule inspection on Thursday.
- Full vendor fee is not refundable for cancellations less than 30 days prior to the event.
- Vendors cannot rent out huts or occupy huts registered to another business.
- K-W Oktoberfest Inc. is not responsible for perishable goods/inventory and makes no representation or warranty with respect to the number of attendees or the actual or potential sales revenue for any vendor.
- Vendors agree to sell only pre-approved product/items at your location. Vendors should be set up a half an hour prior to the hours of operation and are expected to stay open until closing each day. Minimum hours of operation* are: Friday, October 11th, Saturday, October 12th and Sunday, October 13th from 10am-7pm. *Carl Zehr Square vendors are required to be open daily 10am-10pm.
- Teardown and load out of all vendors must be complete by 10am on Monday, October 14th.
- Vendors must comply with local building, fire, health codes and regulations, as well as all licensing requirements. It is the sole responsibility of the vendor to ensure proper documentation is obtained.
- K-W Oktoberfest Inc. cannot be held responsible for items destroyed by vandalism, theft, or any other
 cause and is not responsible for lost or damaged article or displays under any circumstances.
 Overnight security is provided for the duration of the event. However, all items left overnight by vendors
 in their area will be at their own risk.
- Maintain a clean and attractive site at all times.
- Maintain stable pricing so as to avoid inflation or deflation among vendors.
- Vendors are not permitted to sell items beyond their approved booth area.
- All vendors are required to have a fire extinguishers (2A5BC) visible. (These will be provided).
- Vehicles are NOT permitted to park in the Willkommen Platz.
- No smoking or vaping.
- All vendors making sales to the public are responsible for collecting and submitting their own HST.

Additionally, Food Vendors

- Utilize our sponsors' products where applicable. Information on these products will be made available.
- Each individual vendor chosen to participate in the Festival will be responsible to meet the Region of Waterloo Public Health Special Event Food Vendor Requirements for their own food service to the public. We can help guide you through the process, as needed.
- Each vendor is responsible for their own individual expenses incurred in setting up and operating their food booth.
